

Enhancing Research for Africa Network ERFAN Project Activity REPORT YEAR 2022

SUMMARY

This document contains the activities implemented in 2022 by the ERFA Network. The fruitful and inclusive collaboration between all network partners is emphasised, on the basis of which the results would not have been achieved.

All activities, including training, research and working groups meetings, were planned and managed in close cooperation with the WOAH Reference Laboratories (RL) and the Collaborating Centres (CC), established at the Partner Institutions. The ERFAN initiatives were previously discussed and negotiated with the WOAH Sub-Regional Representations in Tunis and Gaborone.

In brief, administrative support was provided to the WOAH Headquarters, a dissemination and communication strategy was developed, one regional meeting was coordinated, 10 WGs online meetings and 7 WGs face-to face meetings were organised; 7 research projects, including doctoral and master's projects, were encouraged and supported in drafting and implementation; 8 (online/in presence) training courses were organised; 13 "Dialogues" were uploaded on the ERFAN website in asynchronous mode.
